

## **Possible Scholarship Opportunities for 2018-19**

**We work in partnership with a number of Universities to offer scholarships each year.**

It is not a requirement that you must apply for admission from our partner universities before submitting an application to us.

For the 2018/19 academic year successfully selected applicants will usually be expected to obtain unconditional admission to an eligible one-year full-time, taught master's degree course at partner institutions by 31 March 2018. Current possible partnerships are below for information and are subject to change.

### **For candidates resident in Commonwealth countries (Kenya and Uganda only)**

Windle Trust International works in partnership with the Commonwealth Scholarship Commission (CSC) as a nominating agency and through its **Fully Funded Commonwealth scholarship scheme** <http://cscuk.dfid.gov.uk/apply/eas/applicants/masters-scholarships/>

Applicants may look at and apply for admission to eligible courses in advance. However, only if you are selected and placed on our priority list may you be invited to submit an application to the CSC as one of our nominated candidates.

**For all candidates:**

**Coventry University** (1 award): For a master's course in The Faculty of Engineering, Environment and Computing.

**Oxford Brookes University** (2 awards): 1 award for the MA Development and Emergency Practice and another for any course in another department.

**University College London (UCL)** (2 awards): 1 award for courses offered by the Institute of Education and 1 award for any course in another University department.

**University of Leeds** (1 award): Any course offered that is related to economic, social or technological development. Courses with very high fees e.g. MBA not included.

**University of Liverpool** (2 awards): Any course offered at the Liverpool campus or London campus, (not the medical courses taught by the Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine that is an independent Institute).

**University of Nottingham** (3 awards): In collaboration with the University's Developing Solutions Scholarships, for courses in the following faculties of Engineering, Medicine and Health Sciences, Science, or Social Science.

**University of Reading** (1 award): Any course at the School of Agriculture, Policy and Development.

**University of Warwick** (2 awards): For the MA English Language Teaching.

**University of Westminster** (2 awards): For any courses offered by the university.



Before submitting your application for a scholarship to Windle you may independently apply for admission from any of our partner-universities or for admission and scholarships from other universities and funding institutions in the UK regardless of whether we select you or not.
